Emergency Alerts, Drills, Missing Persons and Crime



## **Texting/Email Alerts**

Bethany Global University has an emergency number that must be called for all minor and severe emergencies. This line can be used for reporting anything from a break-in to being locked out of your dorm.

This number is: 952-829-2400. When you call this number it will direct you to an answering machine where you will leave your name and details of the incident. The emergency phone service will then let the services department know what is going on and they will take care of it and get back to you.

## **Fire Alarms/Drills**

In the event of a Fire Alarm, proceed to the nearest exit and assemble in the courtyard in front of the administrative building. Once the services department has given permission you may return to your classroom or dormitory. In the event that the Fire Department does arrive, please stay back as far as possible to give them room to work. Do not under any circumstances reenter the building during a fire alarm. You are also required to stay on campus and not leave so that we may keep track of everyone. If you know that someone may be trapped or still inside, please notify a faculty member.

## **Tornado**

In the event of a Tornado or extreme weather event, you will be directed to the lowest floor of the building. Please go quickly and quietly as you wait for further instruction.

## **Missing Person or Crimes**

If you become aware that a fellow student is missing and you are unable to contact him or her, please immediately contact your Student Life Advisor. If they are unavailable, please get in contact with the Dean of Men (for males) or the Dean of Women (for females).
