<b>“C” Country Designation Students</b>	Proof of financial support documentation is not required of C Country Designation students.
<b>Supporters &amp; Sponsors</b>	<p>Many international students are fully or partially supported to attend BGU by one or more churches, ministries and individuals for the purpose of investing in future missionaries or leader in a specific ministry.</p> <p>We suggest you talk with your local church, missions committee and individuals about committing to your training with a one-time or on-going gift. 2. You are required to pay for the entire year in advance by the payment due date for your first semester.
