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Making Spring Semester Payments (“A” and “B” Country Designation Students)

2. Request a payment plan by contacting the Student Billing Office (contact information, below). The payment plan fee is \$150 per semester. The Student Billing Office can provide exact dollar amounts you will owe for each payment.

Making Spring Semester Payments (“C” Country Designation Students only)

1. “C” Country Designation Students are not eligible for a payment plan.
2. You are required to pay for the spring semester in advance by the payment due date (December 1).

Proof of support documentation includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A Proof of Financial Support letter (BGU provides the template form for this) • Supporting documentation giving evidence that the supporter completing the letter has the means to provide the support indicated. (Detailed on the proof of financial support letter) |
| Supporters & Sponsors | <p>Many international students are fully or partially supported to attend BGU by one or more churches, ministries and individuals for the purpose of investing in future missionaries or leader in a specific ministry.</p> <p>We suggest you talk with your local church, missions committee and individuals about committing to your training with a one-time or on-going gift.
