Married student living off-campus: Typically, only married students are allowed to live off-campus. In this case, the student does not qualify for the BGU Student Aid. Only the PT Tuition Scholarship/FWC Award and the Pell Grant, if eligible, is applied to tuition and there is no room and board cost. Therefore, the total annual cost for tuition will range from \$1,225 to \$9,595, depending on Pell eligibility.

Previous bachelor's degree or already reached lifetime Pell eligibility: Students that already have a previous bachelor's degree from another school or have already used their lifetime Pell eligibility of 6 years at other school(s) cannot receive the Pell Grant; therefore, they are partially eligible for Tuition-Paid. They receive \$4,225 of BGU Student Aid and the \$6,675 PT Tuition scholarship stays the same. Therefore, the total cost increases from \$10,620 to \$14,040.
