

Recommended Covid-19 Process and policies approved by BI MLT 08/2021

For Fall 2021 and Spring 2022:

- Beginning Aug. 16, 2021 the following Covid-19 protocols will be followed on campus:
 - The CSM level status will take effect. The status will take effect at 8 a.m. the following day based on active cases of Covid on campus.
 - A CSM status will be determined by the COVID committee on Friday after 3 p.m. for the following week. (In the case of a spike in COVID positive individuals of 10 or more per day, the committee may move the CSM level immediately prior to the following week.)
 - CSM (Covid Spread Mitigation) Levels which are color coded also:
 - CSM Level 5 (RED): 21+ active cases
 - CSM Level 4 (Turquoise): 16-20 active cases
 - CSM Level 3 (YELLOW): 8-15 active cases
 - CSM Level 2 (PINK): 0-7 active cases
 - CSM Level 1 (GREEN): 0 active cases
 - For all CSM levels: The CDC recommends individuals wear a mask, regardless of vaccination status, when exposed to other individuals outside your defined household.
 - CSM 5:
 - Level A employees allowed to work on campus.
 - No in person Chapel. Chapel will be held via streaming with production personnel only in the room.
 - No staff group meeting larger than 6. (Recommend all meetings move to zoom)
 - Socialization in defined household groups only following room size restrictions. (10 for fewer)
 - Household groups defined as Lifegroup
 - Official Lifegroup meetings happen via zoom
 - Assigned Academic Study Groups (5-10) via zoom
 - 10 p.m. curfew on campus - go to your dorm rooms
 - Half In-person classes, NO group projects or group discussions in class
 - Classes will be broken into two groups rotating in person and via link instruction.
 - No group prayer meetings in the Furnace larger than 3

- No in person life group.
 - Students NOT allowed in each other's dorm rooms
 - No one on one studying in person.
 - Gym is open for non-contact individual workouts
 - PMA's via zoom only
 - Visitors to campus must sign a waiver to come on campus.
- CSM 4:
 - Level A and B workers allowed on campus.
 - Socialization allowed on campus in groups no larger than 10.
 - No in person chapel or group meetings larger than 25 –Chapel will be delivered via streaming with production personnel only in the room.
 - No in person life group
 - Students NOT allowed in each other's dorm rooms
 - In person classes (max 50% capacity) all other students on-line, group projects and discussions allowed
 - Gym open for non-contact sports
 - Life groups allowed with COVID-19 protocols
 - Assigned Academic study groups 5-10 allowed with COVID-19 protocols
 - Facility Rentals follow Gov. EO guidelines
- CSM 3:
 - Level A, B and C workers allowed on campus. (All staff currently at BI)
 - Staff working in open cubicle spaces should coordinate with others in that area, so multiple workers are not all in the office on the same day.
 - In person chapel with social distancing in effect
 - Team meetings allowed:
 - 12 or fewer people
 - 60 min. or less
 - OR
 - 12+ people if meeting in space that allows for social distancing between all participants of the duration of the meeting. (No time limit)
 - Gym open: contact sports allowed
- CSM 2:

- All protocols in CSA 3 allowed
- Certain positions may be required to return to campus at the direction of your supervisor. All employees need to coordinate their work situations (in and out of the office) with their supervisor.
- Groups of 20 or fewer can meet without restrictions, but social distancing is recommended.
- Groups of over 20 are allowed to meet for up to 4 hours, while remaining social distanced if possible.
- Visitors are allowed on campus – NOT in Dorms
- CSM 1:
 - Campus is fully open.
 - Staff are required to return to work – can apply for an exception
 - Visitors are allowed on campus – NOT in Dorms
- Vaccine:
 - BI/BGU is not requiring proof of vaccination for a return to campus.
 - We recommend that individuals make their vaccination choice between themselves and their medical practitioner.
