Students in the Certificate in Pre-field Preparation program take a guided curriculum consisting of a mix of requirements and elective coursework in Bible, theology, spiritual development and missions. Students select elective coursework from our freshman and sophomore class listings.

The Pre-field Preparation Certificate is designed for students who are preparing to go out with a ministry or mission organization directly upon completing the certificate or must meet specific educational requirements for their sending entity before being hired or fielded.

All students engage in weekly outreach in local ministry, practical training in a department on campus, weekly life groups and a variety of non-academic conferences and activities focused on preparing for effective ministry and being part of a vibrant Christian community.

Certificate students have the opportunity to participate in an optional 3-week cross-cultural mission trip (TREK) following completion of their program.
