

Placement in Employment

All institutions participating in Title IV, HEA student financial aid programs must make available to prospective and enrolled students, through appropriate publications, mailings, or electronic media, information regarding the placement in employment of, and types of employment obtained by, graduates of the institution's degree or certificate programs.

The following data was collected through a 3-year alumni survey of the graduating class of 2022. 44% of those polled participated (19 out of 43).

40% of respondents reported that they have found employment in their field of study.

The largest employment opportunities were as follows:

- Intermediate or Long-Term Missionary (50%)
- Missionary Candidate (9%)
